



Why are Freight Charges so Expensive?

A variable in the final cost of your products will be freight. Depending on what part of the country you are in will determine how much the freight costs will be. With diesel fuel over \$4.00 per gallon in most parts of the country, delivery charges are at an all time high. Our products are unusually shaped and difficult to handle at times which is a contributing factor to the higher costs.

An option to reduce delivery charges is to use a less than truck load (LTL) freight company. While this may reduce the delivery charge, it may increase the overall freight charge as most LTL companies require enclosed crates. This in turn increases overall weight and the cost of the enclosed crate will need to be passed along.
